# 1. Objectives

## 1.1 Regulation of Commercial Operators

- To provide a framework whereby Council can exercise its responsibility for the management of Tyagarah Airfield by ensuring that commercial air operators operating at Tyagarah are identified as such and known to Council.
- To provide Council staff with clear guidelines in their dealings with existing and proposed commercial air operators.

## 1.2 Payment for Use of Council Property

To provide for a formal relationship between all commercial air operators and Council to facilitate the collection of applicable fees and charges.

# 2. Policy Statement

## 2.1 Commercial Operations

Commercial operations will be defined as all operations for which payments are made to the operator for a service provided.

Commercial operations does not include non-profit operations as defined in Clause 2.2 of this Policy.

## 2.2 Non-Profit Operations

Non-profit operations will be defined as all operations which are run by Non-Profit Organisations incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Act 2009.

## 2.3 Formal Relationships

All commercial air operators operating from Tyagarah Airfield will be required to have a formal relationship with Council by way of a lease at the airfield or, in the case of operations based away from the airfield, a licence to utilise the airstrip.
